Anyone who pays Arizona income tax may be eligible for the tax credits in a collective amount up to your total tax liability.

Donations received by **April 15, 2020** will still receive state tax credit for 2019.

Donation deadline is now extended to Tax Day. You can support both the charitable tax credit & foster care tax credit through SAY.

Take advantage of the Arizona State Tax Credit to help us make a brighter future for nearly 100,000 local youth through SAY!

Arizona tax law allows those who donate through a qualifying umbrella organization like Executive Council Charities SAY, LLC to receive a maximum tax credit of \$800 for joint filers and \$400 for single filers (or married filing separately) when contributions are directed to Qualifying Charities (QC) and an **additional** maximum tax credit of \$1000 for joint filers and \$500 for single filers (or married filing separately) when contributions are directed to Qualifying Foster Care Charities (QFCC).

Single Filers	Joint Filers
\$400 to QC & \$500 to QFCC	\$800 to QC & \$1000 to QFCC
