### Take advantage of the Arizona State Tax Credit to help us make a brighter future for nearly 100,000 local youth through SAY!

Arizona tax law allows those who donate through a qualifying umbrella organization like Executive Council Charities SAY, LLC to receive a maximum tax credit of \$841 for joint filers and \$421 for single filers (or married filing separately) when contributions are directed to Qualifying Charities (QC) and an <a href="additional">additional</a> maximum tax credit of \$1051 for joint filers and \$526 for single filers (or married filing separately) when contributions are directed to Qualifying Foster Care Charities (QFCC).
