Anyone who pays Arizona income tax may be eligible for the tax credits in a collective amount up to your total tax liability.

Donation deadline is now extended to Tax Day. You can support both the charitable tax credit & foster care tax credit through SAY.

Take advantage of the Arizona State Tax Credit to help us make a brighter future for nearly 100,000 local youth through SAY!

Arizona tax law allows those who donate through a qualifying umbrella organization like Executive Council Charities SAY, LLC to receive a maximum tax credit of **\$1,009** for joint filers and **\$506** for single filers (or married filing separately) when contributions are directed to Qualifying Charities (QC) and an **additional** maximum tax credit of **\$1,262** for joint filers and **\$632** for single filers (or married filing separately) when contributions are directed to Qualifying Foster Care Charities (QFCC).
